SUBSCRIPTION RATES

Registered Member (RM) £33

Provides BBKA membership including Public and Product Liability Insurance, **Bee Disease Insurance (BDI)** (up to 3 hives), receipt of NDBKA Newsletter, and attendance at meetings and functions.

Registered Partner (RP) £18

Must have same address as a Registered Member. The subscription includes BBKA partner membership, with same rights and entitlements as a Registered Member, except will not receive Newsletter and BDI is not included.

Country Member (CM) £20.50

For non-beekeeping members, includes BBKA membership without insurance and the same NDBKA rights and entitlements as a Registered Member. BDI not applicable.

Associate Member (AM) £10

Does not include BBKA membership or BDI but otherwise entitled to same NDBKA rights and entitlements as a Registered Member including Newsletter. **Important Note:** Associate members are not insured through NDBKA.

Associate Partner (AP) £4

Must have same address as an Associate Member and will have same NDBKA rights and entitlements, except will not receive Newsletter.

Children may attend meetings and functions as guests at no charge.

Late joining members

On payment of their subscription amount, new members joining between 1st September and 31st December this year will receive membership until 31st December the following year, with the same rights and entitlements as a Registered Member with BBKA capitation at no charge over this period.

Bee Disease Insurance(BDI)

Registered members' subscriptions include Bee Disease Insurance (BDI) for an initial 3 colonies. If you expect to have more than 3 colonies at any time during 2022 then please add the following amount to the basic subscription:
